Extract of the Cl. 6 of the Bye-Laws of the West Bengal State Co-operative Marketing Federation Ltd.

MEMBERSHIP

- 6 (A)** There shall be four classes of memberships as under :-
- (i) “A” Class open to the Co-operative Agricultural Marketing Societies ;
 - (ii) “B” Class, open to the Cooperative Agricultural Processing Societies ;
 - (iii) “C” Class, open to the State Government ; and
 - (iv) “D” Class, open to other types of Agricultural Co-operative Societies who have business connection with the Federation. Such members shall be nominal members without any right to vote in the affairs of the Federation or to participate in the management or in any meeting of the Federation or to share in its profits.
- (B)** Every member other than the State Government and “D” Class members shall, on admission, pay an admission fee of Rs.5 (Rupees five only). Every society applying for “D” class membership shall, on admission, pay an admission fee of Rs.500 (Rupees five hundred only).
- (C)** Every member other than a “D” class member shall hold at least one share.
- (D)** An affiliated society may, by a resolution of its Board of Directors, authorize one of the members of the Managing Committee to act as its representative in the affairs of the Federation.
